

Halloween Pet Parade Fast Facts & Tips

WHAT: Hancock's Resolution Halloween Pet Parade, October 26, 2008, rain or shine. Participants: see rules and fill in application. Spectators: all are welcome.

WHERE: The registration table will be just past the main gate at the entrance to the park. Registration is from 1 to 1:45 pm. The Parade starts at 2:00 pm on the front lawn below the garden. Prizes will be distributed at the event.

PARKING: Cars will park in the field behind the house.

ACCESS: If space is needed for wheelchair viewing, please call 410-255-4048 prior to the day of the parade.

RESTROOMS: Portable restrooms will be to the left of the parking lot as you enter. A Pet Potty area will be provided near the parking lot.

EMERGENCIES: Remember 911 on your cell phones.

LOST AND FOUND: Any articles that are found should be brought to the Main Entrance Tent.

PARENTS: We strongly suggest that parents and guardians ask permission of the owner before attempting to touch the animals.

TIPS

PLAN IN ADVANCE! Bring lawn chairs to make yourself comfortable.

ARRIVE EARLY! We recommend you arrive prior to the start of the parade. This allows time to get settled and comfortable so the parade can begin on time.

PLEASE READ ALL RULES AND REGS CAREFULLY

Any willful infraction(s) will result in the immediate disqualification of your entry and/or removal from the Pet Parade.

The Halloween Pet Parade Committee's decision in all cases will be final.

1. A registration number must be obtained the day of the parade at the registration table between 1:00 pm and 1:45 pm.
2. All animals must show proof of current rabies shots (non cat or dog entrants should provide like medical documentation) to enter the parade.
3. No motorized vehicles will be allowed in the parade area.
4. All animals must be well-behaved and restrained (leash, etc.)
5. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their animals. A Pet Potty area will be available beside the parking lot.
6. Water will be available for pets near the graveyard, the house, and at the lower end of the yard

7. Animals will be required to be with their owners at all times.
8. There will be a roped off area. Participants will gather at the entrance to this area. When the judges indicate they are ready, the MC will announce the participants as they proceed around the ring. The judges will call out numbers that they wish to see for the final decisions. Prizes will be awarded as the announcements are made.
9. Any decisions and interpretation of these rules and regulations involving the Halloween pet Parade Committee on behalf of Hancock's Resolution shall be final.
10. There will be NO Late Registrations!
