Fast Facts & Tips

WHAT: Hancock's Resolution Halloween Pet Parade, October 25, 2026, no rain date.
Participants: see rules and fill in application.
Spectators: all are welcome.

WHERE: The registration table will be next to the entrance gate.
Registration is from 1 to 1:45 pm.
The Parade starts at 2:00 pm. Prizes will be distributed at the event.

PARKING: Cars will be directed to designated areas.

ACCESS: If space is needed for wheelchair viewing, please call 410-952-2798 prior to the day of the parade.

RESTROOMS: Are in the barn/visitor center next to the parking lot.

EMERGENCIES: Remember 911 on your cell phones.

LOST AND FOUND: Any articles that are found should be brought to the Barn/Visitor Center.

PARENTS: We strongly suggest that parents and guardians ask permission of the owner before attempting to touch the animals.

TIPS

PLAN IN ADVANCE! Bring lawn chairs to make yourself comfortable.

ARRIVE EARLY! We recommend you arrive prior to the start of the parade. This allows time to get settled and comfortable so the parade can begin on time.

PLEASE READ ALL RULES AND REGS CAREFULLY

Any willful infraction(s) will result in the immediate disqualification of your entry and/or removal from the Pet Parade.

The Halloween Pet Parade Committee's decision in all cases will be final.

1. A registration number must be obtained the day of the parade at the registration table between 1:00 pm and 1:45 pm.
2. All animals must show proof of current rabies shots (non cat or dog entrants should provide like medical documentation) to enter the parade.
3. No motorized vehicles will be allowed in the parade area.
4. All animals must be well-behaved and restrained (leash, etc.)
5. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their animals.
6. Water will be available for pets at the house.
7. Animals will be required to be with their owners at all times.

8. There will be a designated area. Participants will gather at the entrance to this area. When the judges indicate they are ready, the animals will proceed to the Photo Area. Then the MC will announce the participants as they proceed Down the path to the judges. The judges may call back numbers that they wish to see again for the final decisions. Prizes will be awarded as the announcements are made.
9. Any decisions and interpretation of these rules and regulations by the Halloween Pet Parade Committee on behalf of Hancock's Resolution shall be final.
10. **There will be NO Late Registrations!**
